Changes to Continuing Professional Development

We're getting ready for enhanced CPD, so should you. The changes will take place in January 2018 for dentists and August 2018 for dental care professionals.

What are the main changes?

- An increase in the number of verifiable hours and the requirement to spread the hours more evenly across the five-year cycle (see details in the table below);
- The reduction of CPD hours overall for all dental professionals, due to the removal of non-verifiable CPD;
- The need to make a mandatory annual declaration of the CPD hours you have done and that you are meeting the requirements;
- The requirement of a personal development plan.

The hours required over a five year cycle will be:

Registrant Group	Hours of verifiable CPD per five year cycle
Dentists	100
Dental Therapists	75
Dental Hygienists	75
Orthodontic Therapists	75
Clinical Dental Technicians	75
Dental Nurses	50
Dental Technicians	50

When?

All dentists will move to the new scheme on 1 January 2018 and all dental care professionals on 1 August 2018. There will be transitional arrangements for those who are mid-cycle on these dates and those registrants will have to complete some CPD based on the current scheme and some on the new scheme. We will tell you more about this in the autumn.

What?

You will need to keep a CPD record. This must include:

- A personal development plan which details the CPD you plan to undertake and associated learning outcomes. This may evolve throughout your cycle.
- A log of completed activity, including date, number of hours and which learning outcome it covered.
- The evidence you have collected (e.g. a certificate) for each activity.

Meet the hours requirement

Professional Min. hours/ cycle Dentist 100 Dental therapist 75 Dental hygienist 75 Orthodontic therapist 75 Clinical dental technician 75 Dental nurse 50 Dental technician 50

Remember:

You need to do CPD regularly, at least 10 hours every 2 years

Enhanced CPD: Your 5 year cycle

Keep a CPD record

This needs to include:

- 1) Your personal development plan (PDP)
- 2) Your log of CPD activity completed
- 3) Documentary evidence (e.g. certificate) from the CPD provider for all activity completed

Each CPD activity needs at least one of the GDC's learning outcomes

Make your annual declaration

You will be declaring:

- The number of CPD hours you have done in that year;
- That you have kept a CPD record;
- That the activity you have done is relevant to your practice as a professional.

You can log onto EGDC at any time to make your declaration for each year
